

Preparing your Car for Driving Test

Test Vehicle Self Check List: What you need to keep in mind before presenting your car for driving test.

- You must be insured to drive the vehicle you are providing for the test.
- The vehicle must display a current valid Insurance disc
- The vehicle must display a current valid NCT disc
- The vehicle must display a current valid Motor Tax disc
- Proper **L** plates must be fitted to the front and back of your car
- Makes sure that Brake and indicator lights are working.
- The tyres must have a minimum thread depth of 1.6mm
- Make sure you present the vehicle in clean hygienic condition

You will be asked to switch on/off, or adjust any 3 of the following:

(a) The wiper(s)	(b) The lights, dipping the headlights	(c) The windscreen washer
(d) The fan	(e) The air vents	(f) The rear window heater
(g) The air-conditioner	(h) The temperature control	(i) The rear fog lights
(j) The air intake control	(k) Hazard warning switch	(l) Driver seat/headrest

You may be asked to verbally explain how to perform a Technical check on any 3 of the following, selected at random by the tester:

(a) The tyres	(b) The lights	(c) The reflectors
(d) The indicators	(e) The engine oil	(f) The coolant
(g) The horn	(h) The steering	(i) The brakes fluid
